# 23.004 Minutes of the Previous Meeting

## 23.005 Expenditure Against Budget

# 23.007 WHPC Community Grants Awards Scheme

Members reviewed an application from West Horsley Place for £1500. This is to contribute towards the cost of repairs to corroded guttering by lining with modern plastic alternatives. This will allow the Trust to leave historic examples of guttering in situ, to preserve the features of the house's exterior. The application was approved.

# 23.009 Village Hall Invoicing

Members agreed to move to monthly invoicing for Village Hall room bookings, to enable better monitoring of spend against budget.

# 23.010 Village Garden Party & Sunflower Field Project

Members received a briefing note on income and expenditure for the 2022 garden party (cancelled) and the sunflower field project. Members agreed a contribution of £1660.05 was appropriate, to come from its Earmarked Reserve for Village Fete. This would cover the cost of preparing the sunflower field, purchasing and sowing the seeds, and the non-recoverable costs of insurance and entertainment for the cancelled garden party.

The Finance Committee will recommend to Full Council on 17th January that it approves a
payment of £1600.05, so long as invoices for all items can be provided.
